

Historical timeline

- 1896 The first film screening in Norway.
- 1904 Norway's first regular movie theatre in Kristiania (Oslo's former name).
- 1913 The Public Screening of Cinematographic Images Act.
- 1917 The National Association of Municipal Cinemas (NAMC) was established.
- 1930 Film & Kino, Norway's oldest film periodical, was established under the name of the Norwegian Film Magazine ("Norsk Filmblad").
- 1932 NAMC and Norwegian municipalities established the production company Norwegian Film ("Norsk Film").
- 1950 The Mobile Cinema ("Norsk Bygdekino") was established.
- 1970 The Norwegian Cinema and Film Foundation was established during NAMC's general assembly.
- 1987 The Norwegian Cinema and Film Foundation was instructed to collect charges on cinema ticket sales and rentals of films and videogrammes pursuant to the Film and Videogramme Act.
- 1987 NAMC assumed responsibility for the Mobile Cinema.
- 2002 The General Assembly changed NAMC's name to Film & Kino.
- 2007 The 90th anniversary of Film & Kino.
